Happy Feast of Our Lady of Fatima! I believe we all know the importance, especially in these times so sorrowful for Our Mother, of having a devotion to the "Five First Saturdays." The main message was to pray the Rosary for Peace in the world, for the salvation of souls, and in reparation to Our Lady's Immaculate Heart. Look at the world, look at souls in the world...do you think we done a good job? Maybe we should double our efforts in praying the Rosary for those same intentions that are immeasurably important.

But for those who understand and live the Gift of "Living in the Divine Will," we can offer our acts everyday for His Kingdom to come, for His Will to be done on earth as It is done in Heaven, which is the totality of every prayer and the reason that Jesus taught us that one and only prayer, the Our Father!

I am sure most of you already understand what has been explained about why God has created us, and how God wants to live in us! We have learned that the only reason God went ahead with creation, after he foresaw the fall of Adam, was because God's love is greater than the sin of Adam and is greater than all sin put together. Also, because The Word, Jesus, said He would come and redeem the fall. But also He foresaw that the same unity that He was to have with Adam in the beginning, and that He wished to have with all of His creatures, would become a reality again through souls that would live in His Holy Will. He foresaw the 'Era of Peace', the new 'Springtime of the Church' when all souls would be living that same unity with Him that He would have had with Adam in the beginning, if not for the fall, which was our Father's only reason for creation!

If this was the only reason He created us then the most important thing to Him **MUST** be the return of this unity with His creatures, His beloved children! If we do not return to the original state of justice, then it means that Lucifer wins; but our Almighty Father will never allow that to happen!

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Don't get me wrong! The devotion to the "Five First Saturdays" is immensely important and a devotion I practice with great love for Our Lady of Fatima...but it is a devotion. The Living in the Divine Will is Life! It is not a devotion that you accomplish once a month or once a day, but a LIFE you live every second! So along with your true devotion to the "Five First Saturdays," always important and which should always be constant, offer also you acts in the Divine Will for this reparation and plea for peace in the world, so torn apart and suffering! But also for His Kingdom to come, which will bring to the earth all the joy, peace, abundance, and love of God and all of Heaven! May It come soon!!

In closing this newsletter, I am including our beloved and late Sr. Lucy's own words of how she lived her devotion to the "Five First Saturdays."

### ***"Here is my way of making the meditations"***

*In this devotion that is so simple and so easy, Sister Lucy writes to her mother, "it seems to me that the fifteen minutes of meditation are what might give you some difficulty. But it is quite easy." We have said that it is a question only "of keeping Our Lady company for fifteen minutes" and it is not at all necessary to meditate on all fifteen mysteries of the Rosary, but one or two can be chosen. Sister Lucy writes:*

*"Here is my way of making the meditations on the mysteries of the Rosary on the first Saturdays: First mystery, the Annunciation of the Angel Gabriel to Our Lady. First prelude: to imagine myself seeing and hearing the Angel greet Our Lady with these words:*

*"Hail Mary, full of grace." Second prelude: I ask Our Lady to infuse into my soul a profound sentiment of humility.*

*"1st point: I will meditate on the manner in which Heaven proclaims that the Most Holy Virgin is full of grace, blessed among all women and destined to become the Mother of God.*

*"2nd point: The humility of Our Lady, recognizing Herself and declaring Herself to be the handmaid of the Lord.*

*"3rd point: How I must imitate Our Lady, in Her humility, what are the faults of pride and arrogance through which I most often displease the Lord, and the means I must employ to avoid them, etc.*

*"On the second month, I make the meditation on the second joyful mystery. The third month, I make it on the third joyful mystery and so on, following the same method of meditating. When I have finished the Five First Saturdays, I begin five others and meditate on the sorrowful mysteries, then the glorious ones, and when I have finished them I start over again with the joyful ones."*

*Sister Lucy thus reveals to us that far from contenting herself with the Five First Saturdays, every month she practices "the lovable reparatory devotion" indicated by Our Lady. Since it is a question of "consoling Our Heavenly Mother" and interceding so efficaciously for the salvation of souls, why not follow her example and renew this pious practice often? We could then ask this good Mother, with the firm hope of being heard, to vouchsafe to grant particular assistance at the hour of death, "with all the graces necessary for salvation", for any soul whom we confide to Her, as She has promised to us in return for this "little devotion" accomplished through love and a spirit of Reparation.*
